### *Quenetta Myers Seabrook*

She was the daughter of the late Reverend John Myers and Leola Gilliard Myers. The fifth of seven children, she was born and raised in the town of Mt. Pleasant, SC where she attended Sunday school and service at Friendship AME Church all of her life until relocating to Charleston for a number of years. While living in Charleston, she attended Emanuel AME Church and was an associate member of the Richard Allen Choir for a number of years. She then relocated back to Mt. Pleasant and lived the balance of her life and attended Friendship AME Church.

She was educated in the public school system. She graduated first in the class of 1947 of Laing High School. She attended Allen University in Columbia, SC where she received a BS degree in elementary education and attended the Citadel for extended studies. She taught as an elementary school teacher at Laing. She also taught school at Sullivan's Island Elementary, being the only black teacher for a number of years. She retired from S. I. Elementary after 30 years of dedicated service.

She was married to William Seabrook Sr. and from that union two sons were born, William Jr. and Vincent. She enjoyed cooking, gardening and keeping in touch with neighbors and loved ones. She was a caregiver to those family members who needed it, especially her husband for a number of years until his health failed.

She worked as a retired, part time employee at the Post and Courier newspaper in sales and marketing. She was a member of Friendship AME's Junior Choir, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. and Eastern Light Chapter No. 360 O.E.S. She was also a lifelong member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Herbert U Mack, Post 241. She worked as a volunteer for the March of Dimes and the American Heart Association.

She is survived by her son Vincent, three devoted nieces, Donna Conyers, Jerelyn Eddings and Felecia Sanders and countless other relatives and friends.

## **I've Done My Work**

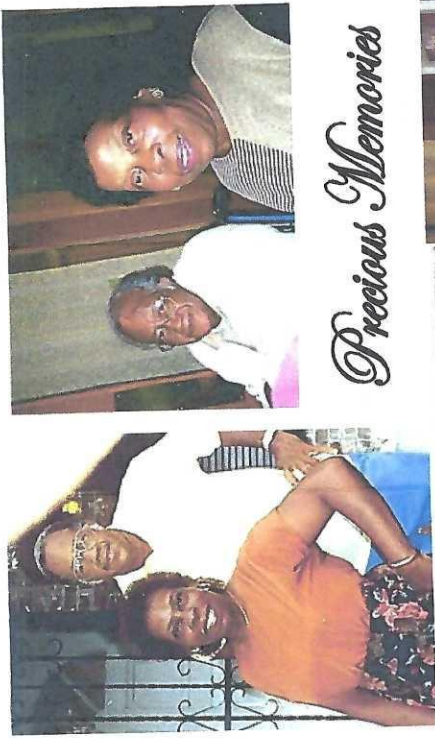
I've done my work, I've sung my song,

the way to Him I know.

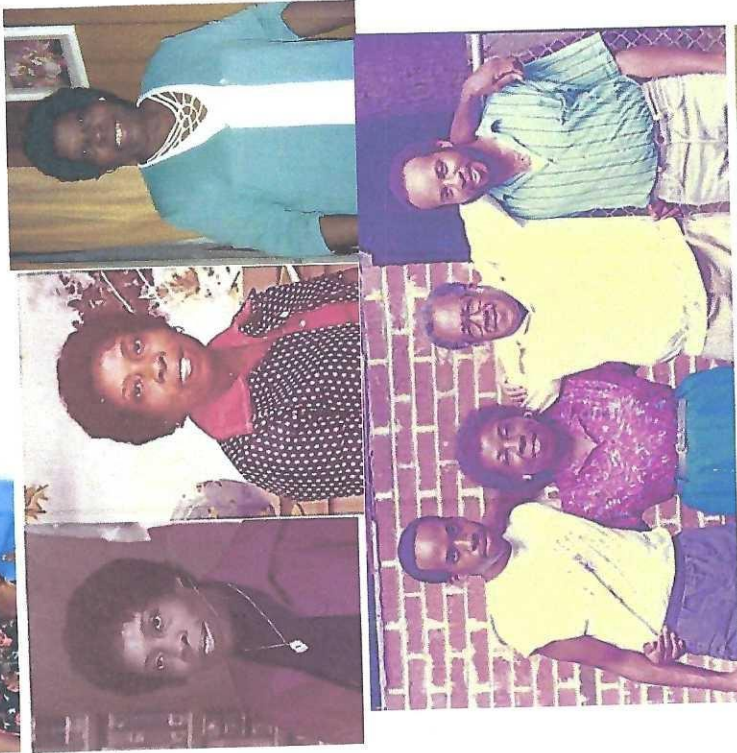
He knows my soul so weak and blind,
